Coteaux du Vendômois Blanc "Lieu-Dit, Cocagne"





LOCATION: The place named "Cocagne" is located on the banks of the Loir in the commune of Lunay. The grapes grow on slopes that constitute the finest terroir in the appellation.

TERROIR: Soil:

The place named Cocagne features soil consisting of clay (20 %) with Turonian limestone parent rock and a large quantity of pink flint on the surface. This terroir provides excellent water supply and drainage.

Sun exposure:

Cocagne, is located on an east-facing slope in a part of the Loir Valley with many bends that gives the region a microclimate conducive to winegrowing.

Climate:

Temperate climate. The vineyard is protected from northerly winds and has a microclimate conducive to grape growing thanks to the influence of the Loir river.

WINEMAKING: Light pneumatic pressing. 24-hour static clarification of the must

Fermentation at 14°C in temperature-controlled stainless steel vats.

AGEING: This "Lieu-Dit Cocagne" was aged on its lees for several months.

VARIETALS: Chenin 100%

FOOD PAIRINGS: Ideal as an aperitif or with pork, sushi, fish, seafood, goat's cheese, fruit salad, etc.
