Touraine Sauvignon Grain d'Expression





LOCATION: The vines of the Touraine Sauvignon cuvée are located around the commune of Saint-Romain-sur-Cher, on the slopes of the Cher.

TERROIR: Sandy soil on clay.

WINEMAKING: Vinification followed without sulphur, with temperature control (17°C) to preserve the aromatic potential of the Sauvignon. No malolactic fermentation.

VARIETALS: Sauvignon

SERVING: Taste it fresh (10-12°C)

FOOD PAIRINGS: Served chilled, it will ideally accompany your aperitifs with goat cheese specialities.
